



## Youth Mental Health Survey

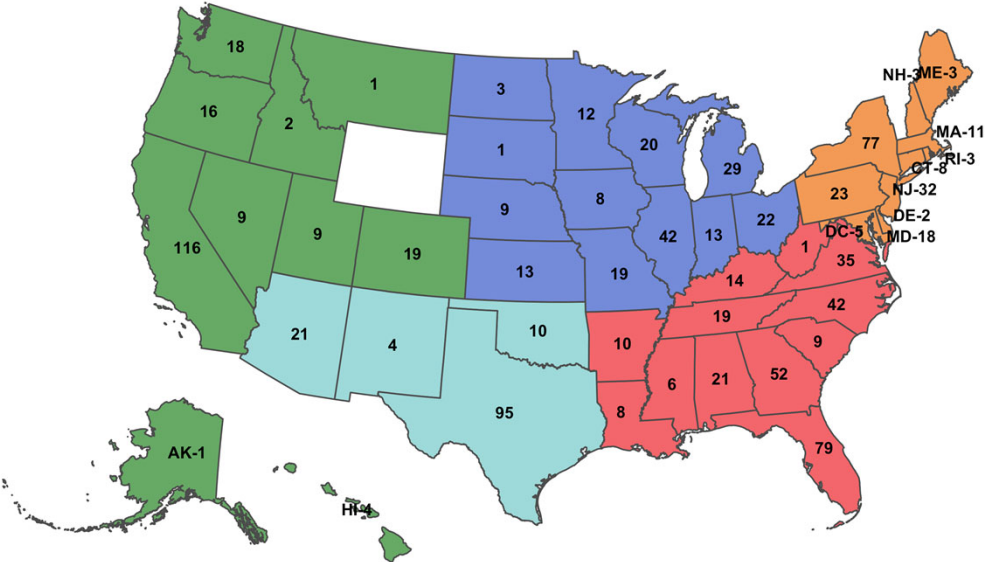
Sample size: 1000

Margin of Error for Sample: 3.1%

### Methodology Summary:

This sample of 1000 teenagers (ages 16-19) in was surveyed between October 2nd, 2020 and October 4th, 2020. DKC Analytics conducted and analyzed this survey with a sample procured using the Pollfish survey delivery platform, which delivers online surveys globally through mobile apps and the mobile web along with the desktop web. Gender was balanced 50/50 in the sample, and no other weighting was applied in sampling or analysis.
